

PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES

- 1. See the pickleball schedule for open pickleball play
- 2. All levels of play are welcome
- 3. Court time will be shared equally
- 4. There are no designated courts for level of play
- 5. Games are played to 11, win by 2
- 6. When there are 5 or more players waiting to play, we will abide by the 4 on 4 off etiquette. 4 players leave the court once the game is over so 4 new players can enter and play.
- Rally scoring will start when there are more than 8 players waiting. Rally scoring will play to 15. Rally scoring rules are posted on the YMCA website. (Rally scoring: Every ralley scores a point, regardless who serves)
- 8. When players are done playing, they sit at the end of the bench and wait until they are up to play again
- 9. Players are limited to no more than 2 continuous games
- 10. At the end of each game, two players from the 'losing team' will leave the court while the winning team players will stay on the court. The winning players will split and become opponents of each other to start the next game
- 11. If a group of players wish to play together, they will allow other players to move ahead of them to complete a foursome, then they can play together

12. Stay off any court where there is scheduled YMCA programming on the red court

13. When there are at least 5 people waiting, 4 players will leave the court after each game is finished
