



# YMCA Youth Development Agreement and Permission Form

Please complete and sign this form and return it to the YMCA Youth Development Department.

1. I give permission for the YMCA to apply sunscreen, bug spray, and/or triple antibiotic cream as needed. I have informed the staff of any allergies to these substances.
2. I agree to provide the necessary food when my child participates in summer day camp. The Y will typically provide a morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack. Campers may bring food from home if the choose.
3. I have read the YMCA Summer Camp Handbook and agree to follow the policies therein.
4. I understand that the YMCA has the right to terminate care, without notice if 1) camp fees are not paid when due; 2) the child's participation in the program creates a direct threat of harm to the child, other children, or YMCA staff; 3) parent engages in inappropriate behavior as defined in the parent handbook.
5. I understand the program may be closed due to loss of electricity, communicable disease outbreaks, etc. and agree to make arrangements for alternate emergency care for these situations.

**Emergency Contact & Release of Child:** List all individuals, including parents/legal guardians, in order of preference, to be contacted in an emergency. If possible, include at least one person other than the parents/legal guardians to be contacted in an emergency and to whom the child can be released. The second phone number column can be left blank. (If more individuals, attach additional sheets.)

## MEDICAL EMERGENCY CARE AUTHORIZATION

Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs

**Notice:** By signing this form you are granting the operator of the camp organization authority to secure emergency medical, surgical treatment for your camper while attending camp if there is insufficient time to contact you.

You are giving the camp operator permission to secure routine, nonsurgical medical care for your child while attending camp.

In accordance with MCLA Act 116 of the Public Acts of 1973 and the rules for licensing children's camps, this authorization must be signed by a parent or guardian unless there is religious objection.

MCLA 722.124a, Section 124a(2) states: "A parent or guardian of a minor child who voluntarily places the child in a child care organization shall execute a written instrument investing the organization with authority to consent to emergency medical and surgical treatment of the child. The parent or guardian shall consent to routine, nonsurgical medical care.

I hereby give permission to the children's camp named below, which is licensed by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, to secure emergency medical and surgical treatment and to provide routine, nonsurgical medical care, for the minor child named above, while attending camp.
