POSITION SUMMARY:

We are seeking staff members to partner with us on our new early center on the Northside. The YMCA is committed to providing a high-quality experience for staff and students of the neighborhood. Under the guidance of the Early Learning Coordinator and Lead Teacher, support staff will provide direct supervision to children in the program by implementing planned activities while creating a caring, inclusive, and safe environment. Staff will help ensure the program meets all state licensing regulations and Association policies and procedures, including our commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion.

- 7. Remain current in CPR and First Aid to be able to appropriately handle emergency situations
- 8. As required by Michigan law, report any suspected incidence of child abuse to the program director.

OUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Must be at least 16 years of age
- 2. High school diploma preferred
- 3. Experience with children is preferred
- 4. Demonstration of a commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion
- 5. Residence or ties to the Northside neighborhood preferred.
- 6. CPR and First Aid certifications must be obtained within the first 30 days of hire.

WORK ENVIRONMENT & PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Must be able to physically participate in activities with children.
- Daily cleaning is required.
- Proof of negative TB test within the past year.
