JOB TITLE: Early Learning Staff

POSITION SUMMARY:

Provide direct supervision to children in the Early Learning program by implementing planned activities while providing for the care, safety, and growth of all children. Other responsibilities include providing quality experience to children and parents focusing on YMCA core values: honesty, respect, responsibility and caring.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

5. Appropriately handle all emergency situations, remain current in CPR/First Aid certifications.
6. As required by Michigan law, report any suspected incidence of child abuse to the Program Director.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma
2. Must be at least 18 years of age
3. Experience with children preferred
4. First Aid and CPR certifications must be obtained within the first 30 days of hire.

WORK ENVIRONMENT & PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Must be able to physically participate in activities with children.
- Daily cleaning is required.
- Proof of negative TB test within a year.
