

ACCESS FOR ALL: MAKING NEW IMPACTS



Adaptive Programming, designed for children and youth with special needs or disabilities, was a focus in 2023 in the Aquatics and Tennis departments. In the pool, the class served as a beginning swim experience where participants were able to develop introductory swim skills and worked their way toward learning water safety. On the Tennis court, in addition to the introduction of Wheelchair Tennis events, an inclusive approach to "everybody plays" provided opportunity for wheelchaired youth and adults to play and compete by adopting rules to make play equitable.

Northside Early Learning, our newest preschool program partnered with Bogan Developments, opened for the 2023–24 school year to expand the Y's footprint in the Northside neighborhood. With over 15 students in its inaugural year, the preschool program provides support to young families in an under-served Kalamazoo core neighborhood and compliments our programs at Lincoln International Studies School.





Significant renovations and footprint changing improvements were made in the Maple locker rooms leading into Aquatics program areas where walls and doors were removed to create a new vestibule featuring barrier-free access points.
