- Report any suspected child abuse to Association OST Director immediately.
- Support OST Site-Specialist and/or other YMCA OST staff with light office work. This may include but not limited to:
 - Assigning trainings to staff, communicating with parents, assisting with billing, etc.
- Other tasks as assigned.
