## **POSITION SUMMARY:**

The YMCA of Greater Kalamazoo offers a before and after school program called Prime Time at several area elementary schools in both Portage and Kalamazoo. OST Site Specialists will work with front-line staff and the OST team to create a high-quality program at a designated OST site. Staff will provide overall program guidance and direct supervision to children while modeling our core values of integrity, collaboration, diversity, and health.

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Availability during all hours of operation; M-F 6:30am-9:00am and 3:15pm-6:00pm.
- 2. Provide daily direction and oversight of assigned program site to ensure program runs smoothly and efficiently each day
- 3. Develop and help facilitate educational and engaging activities for children ages K-5th grade
- 4. Develop and demonstrate knowledge of childcare licensing requirements
- 5. Ensure program records are complete and kept confidential as required
- 6. Develop relationships with staff, students, and families to ensure open communication is maintained throughout the school year.
- 7. Commit to expanding your skills and knowledge with required and recommended trainings
- 8. Follow all guidelines related to the CACFP including acquiring snack, posting menus, and completing snack records and other paperwork as needed.
- 9. Remain current in CPR and First Aid to be able to appropriately handle emergency situations
- 10. As required by Michigan law, report any suspected incidence of child abuse to the Association OST Director and Children's Protective Services (appropriate legal authority).





### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Must be at least 19 years of age.
- 2. High school diploma, GED, or equivalent.
- 3. Education and experience equivalent to one of the following options or willingness to obtain:
  - a. A minimum of 6 semester hours in child-related field and 2,880 hours of experience.
  - b. Sixty semester hours with 12 hours in child-related field and 720 hours of experience.
  - c. Associates degree in child-related field and 480 hours of experience
  - d. Bachelor's degree or higher in child-related field.
- 4. Must be able to pass comprehensive background check.
- 5. Current First Aid and CPR certifications.

#### **WORK ENVIRONMENT & PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

- Must be able to participate in activities with children
- Daily cleaning to maintain a safe and healthy space
- Proof of negative TB test
