POSITION SUMMARY:

This position supports the work of the Y, a leading nonprofit committed to strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.

Provides direct leadership, instruction and motivation for students in swimming classes.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Instruct swimming lessons as assigned in accordance with YMCA guidelines, having prepared lesson plans accordingly. (Responsibility, Respect, Caring)
- Develop positive relationships with members and participants and provides motivational support and guidance. (Caring, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty, Cause Driven, Exceed Expectation)
- 3. Encourage member and parent involvement and identifies potential volunteers. (Responsibility, Respect, Caring)
- 4. Convey information on aquatics programs and schedules and as appropriate refers members and participants to other programs (Responsibility, Respect, Caring)
- 5. Maintain records as required (i.e. attendance, progress reports, etc.).(Responsibility, Honesty)
- 6. Attend staff meetings and trainings as scheduled. (Responsibility, Respect)
- Follow all YMCA policies, rules, regulations and procedures, including emergency and safety procedures. Complete incident and accident reports as necessary. (Caring, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty, Cause Driven, Exceed Expectation)
- 8. Organize and puts away needed class equipment. Reports damaged equipment. (Responsibility, Caring, Respect)
- 9. Train and supervises class aides as assigned.(Responsibility, Cause Driven)
