# DEAR FRIENDS,

At the YMCA of Greater Kalamazoo, 2022 was another remarkable year of positively impacting people of all walks of life. We focused on developing our children, improving our health, and motivating others to support their neighbors and the larger community, making Kalamazoo County a better place to live.

Y staff and volunteer leadership started the year with a self-assessment of the Association, immediately noticing a gap in our organizational strategy. While our values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility had been serving us well for many years, we recognized that we needed to further articulate our core values to better guide our future work.

So we embarked on a journey to revisit our core values.

This deep-dive into our belief system was designed to help us identify values that better represent and align with our purpose and responsibility. We knew,

ultimately, that these new core values would need to guide our program and service planning, as well as our organizational culture for future generations. We would depend on them to drive innovation and guide how our organization operates across all levels and interactions.

So, after much work, this group of Y leaders came up with a more robust and comprehensive set of core values—Integrity, Collaboration, Diversity, and Health.

#### So what does that all mean?

When we say **Integrity** we mean we will choose courage over comfort. We will choose what is right over what is fun, fast, or easy. We will choose to practice our values rather than simply professing them.

When we say **Collaboration** we mean we will strategically and equitably find partners whose values align with ours, to increase opportunities exponentially. We will see every relationship as critical.


